

Westran PTO February 2022 Meeting Minutes

Date, Time, and Location: Wednesday, Feb 9, 2022, at 6 p.m. at the Elementary School

Meeting called to order by President Renae Fuemmeler at 6:15 p.m.

Treasurer Report given by Breanne Goble. Checking balance of \$1,458.19 & Savings balance of \$22,947.63.

Old Business

Discussed the new playground that will be built over the summer in time for the 22-23 school year. The firetruck will be refurbished and remain part of the playground. The playground will be fenced in and locked, only to be used during school hours. There was discussion about whether or not to use PTO funds for the new playground as previously intended since money has become available to the school. Mike Nagel mentioned that they could come up short and come to us. We tabled this discussion.

The Spring Carnival is still tentatively set for April 1st. More to come and discuss at the next meeting in March.

New Business

PTO member Nikki Jacoby was recently injured and Breanne suggested we put together a care package on behalf of PTO. After discussion, it was agreed to provide two Dinner's Ready meals and two cases of water. Ashley made a motion to approve.

Penny Wars raised \$412.98. Second grade won.

Renae shared that PTO contributed \$1,000 to the Fill the Truck Toy Drive, which went specifically towards utility bills for local families.

Discussed the condition of the PTO shed. Renae proposed that we replace it soon as repairs aren't feasible at this point. Asked that we consider a reasonable dollar amount.

Discussed upcoming classroom Easter parties and how we wanted to handle them. PTO has several eggs to provide upon request. It was decided that we would ask teacher's to have their kids to bring in a bag of candy per child and PTO would meet to sort the candy and fill eggs. We will finalize during March meeting.

Renae and Breanne purchased water and soda for the elementary teachers for "Fill the Fridge February". The total cost was \$80.25. Ashley formally motioned to approve this expenditure and it was seconded by Chelsey.

Renae proposed starting the "Smile Cart" up again for Aubrey Emmerich. This would run during the months of March, April and May of 2022. The initiative includes purchasing snacks and drinks to be

distributed by Aubrey, along with her aide, once a week using the Smile Cart. Ashley motioned to approve and was seconded by Jenn.
