- Renae proposed theme "Bringing Back Fun for the Whole Family". Randi made a motion to approve the theme and Niki seconded.
- Tannie Howard will chair the games. Discussed what games/activities we currently have and what we would be open to including this year. Tannie to reach out separately to individuals who offered support to coordinate games. Goal is 11 games.
- Breanne, Renae and Niki will oversee the Silent Auction preparations.
- Discussed whether or not to offer tie-dye shirts and decided to forego them this year and instead offer white drawstring bags and fabric paint to decorate them. Renae will price bags tomorrow and see if they will be available in time.
- Discussed offering various items to be raffled for children and adults.
- Will offer tattoos instead of face paint.

 - o Games will start at 530pm and run until 730pm.
 - o Silent Auction starts at 5pm and bidding will stop at 8pm.
